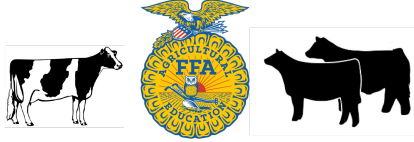

12:00 PM - Barn Opens for Early Arrivals

5:00 - 7:00 PM - Early Bird Check In for Registered animals ONLY

9:00 PM - Barn closes for the night

#### Saturday February 5th:

5:00 AM - Barn opens for arrival

7:00 - 9:00 AM - Check In/ Weigh In

10:00 AM - Showmanship (youngest to oldest)

## General Show Rules, Regulations, & Information

1. All beef heifers must be born January 1, 2020 and after. It is recommended that steers are born August 1, 2020 and after. Dairy heifers must be born between March 1 and September 30, 2021.
2. Any exhibitor 21 years of age or under is eligible to show.
3. A valid health certificate is required and will be checked upon arrival.
4. Entries are open to the world. Market steers, market heifers, commercial dairy heifers and commercial beef heifers will be shown by weight. Purebred heifers with registration papers will be shown by breed by age.
5. The barn will open on Friday, February 4th at 12 noon and on Saturday, February 5th at 5 AM. Check in will be Friday 5-7 pm for registered heifers and on Saturday from 7 - 9 am for registered heifers and weigh in of all commercial and market animals.
6. There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor.
7. Awards will be given to the top 3 in each class and each division.
8. All entries must be submitted by January 21, 2022 through [theshowportal.com](http://theshowportal.com). The entry fee is \$40 per head including a mandatory \$10 shavings fee. A late fee of \$15.00 per head will be required for entries after this date until January 28, 2022. **NO ENTRIES AFTER JANUARY 28 WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
9. Cattle do not have to be entered in the State Cattle Show to enter this show.
10. Showmanship will be broken up by age or a combination of ages (depending on number of entries).
11. **Steer Show:** All steers will be shown by weight.
12. **Market Heifer Show:** All market heifers will be shown by weight. Market heifers have the option of competing in the commercial beef heifer class but there will be an additional entry fee.
13. **Heifer Show:** Heifers will be shown according to breed and should have valid registration papers. The show will require there be a minimum of 6 heifers pre-entered to constitute a breed class. Breeds that do not meet this minimum will be shown in AOB. Top three in each breed will be named and the top two will return for the supreme heifer drive. Commercial heifers will be shown by weight and beef heifers are eligible to compete in the market heifer division with an additional entry fee.
